




## Year 4 - end of year assessment

### Listening:

*Can I listen and recognise key vocabulary as words and in short sentences?*

I will read 4 sentences, just write the number of the sentence when you hear each word. (E.g. If the first sentence was je mange du pain avec de la confiture. You would put a number '1' under the bread and the jam.)

*Can I listen and demonstrate understanding of words, simple and more complex familiar phrases and sentences?*
