Dear Parents and Carers,

As there have been some considerable changes to our governing board since you last heard from us directly, we wanted to take this opportunity to introduce ourselves and what the governing board does.

We work as a group of volunteers and represent the best interests of all the children at Warstones Primary School. Every school has a governing board, and it is our responsibility to:

- Set the vision and values for the school
- Make sure the finances are well managed
- Support and challenge the school to make sure the children have the very best possible outcomes

We have two Chairs, Charlotte Harding & Simon Penfold, and a Vice-Chair, Rachel Bailey and our governing board is made up of staff, parents and other members of our community, all of whom bring different skills to the Governing Board.

Our role is purely strategic – it is not our responsibility to get involved in the day to day operations of the school. We do though make sure we support Mrs Feeney and her team, make sure that policies and procedures are in place and are effective, and question and challenge decisions and outcomes.

We meet every half-term and discuss all manner of subjects, including the children's progress, safeguarding, health and safety, staff and pupil wellbeing and how we are doing against our financial budgets.
