



# Warstones Primary School Remote Learning Provision Map

## Online Learning and Home Learning Packs

All home learning is **COMPULSORY**.

This map shows the expectations from us as a school as to what the children access throughout the day for remote learning. As a general rule with the online learning, please prioritise the activities that the teachers have set on Purple Mash/Tapestry, as well as any home reading. Wider curriculum activities can be completed throughout the day, depending on the needs of your child, as the work set may take some children longer than others. The government have set a requirement of between 3-5 hours of schooling per day. You should always take into consideration the wellbeing of your child and alter your day accordingly. It may be that for younger children, this time is filled with practical, creative activities alongside the work set by the teacher.

Please also see a list of websites that you may find useful during this time as an extension to their learning. This is not an exhaustive list. Many museums, zoos, national trust sites and other public places and events do virtual tours and events that may stimulate interest and support the wider, inspirational curriculum.
